Legal Requirements for marriage in Jamaica

Required Documents:

- Passport or Driver's License
- Birth Certificate.
- Final Divorce Decree/Decree Absolute (where applicable).
- Death Certificate (where applicable).
- Certified documents supporting any change of name (where applicable).
- If you under eighteen years of age, a Letter of Consent is required from your legal Parent/Guardian signed in the presence of and certified by a Justice of the Peace.
- If originals are in another language they should be translated by certified translators whose certifications of authenticity should be attached.

Notes: Once the documents are found to be satisfactory the License will be issued. Please note that all documents presented must be in English. If either of the parties is residing abroad, twenty-four (24) hours residence in the Island is required at which time a local address can be used.
